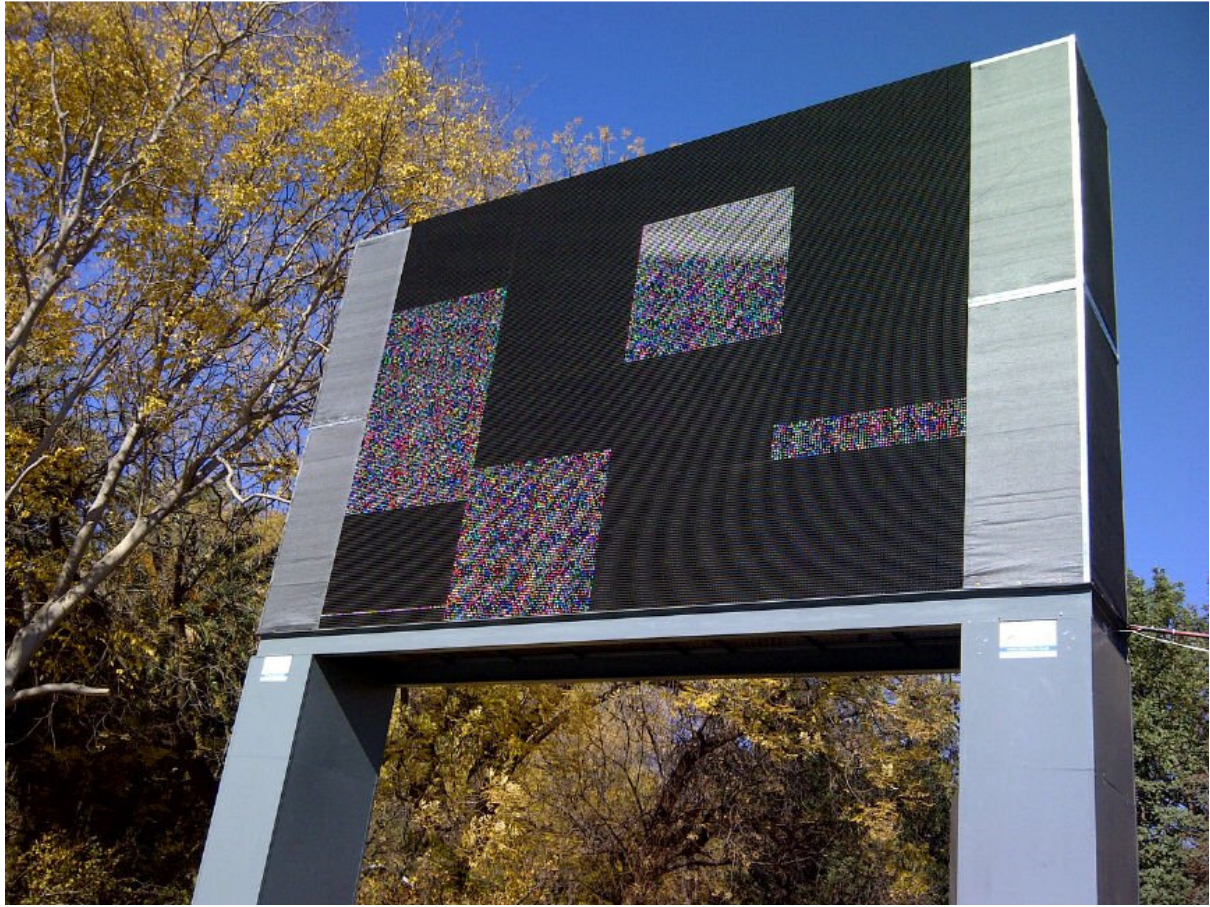


John Taolo Gaetsewe District Municipality in Partnership with Anglo American mine (Kumba) for Big Screen Installation
