The 80/20 principle will be applied, in terms of the Supply Chain Management Policy of Council when bids are evaluated which is available upon request.

The John Taolo Gaetsewe District Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any bid and the Municipality reserves the right to accept the whole or part of any bid. No reasons for the acceptance or rejection of any bid will be given.

Bid will be adjudicated according to the John Taolo Gaetsewe District Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy, the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act 5 of 2005) and the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, as well as the Broad Base Black Economic Empowerment Act (Act 53 of 2003).
