EPWP Projects -2012/2013

During the 2012/2013 financial year, there were 14 (fourteen) EPWP projects which were successfully implemented by the John Taolo District Municipality. Funding was availed through the EPWP incentive grant from The Department of Public Works and all projects were initially approved by council.

The projects mainly involved the cleaning and de-bushing of graveyards in various villages and each project had a duration of 3 months to completion. These projects included:

- Mapoteng cleaning of grave yard
- Magojaneng cleaning of grave yard
- ◆ Churchhill cleaning of grave yard
- ♦ Wrenchville cleaning of grave yard
- Pietbos cleaning and fencing of grave yard
- ◆ Gasehubane cleaning and fencing of grave yard
- ◆ Tsineng cleaning of grave yard
- ♦ Mokalamosesane cleaning of grave yard
- ◆ Cleaning of Kalahari high school
- Deben cleaning of grave yard
- ♦ Olifantshoek cleaning of grave yard and internal roads
- ◆ Mothibistad cleaning of grave yard
- Mothibistad Debushing

Beneficiaries from each village included both men and women with an emphasis also on the youth and the disadvantaged. The strategic intent was a to embark on a short-to-medium term projects identified in the municipality's IDP so as to alleviate ad reduce unemployment through creating work opportunities and on instances coupled with training.

These projects were implemented under the Code of Good Practice for employment and conditions of work for special public works programme as well as the framework for the implementation of labour intensive projects under the Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP)
